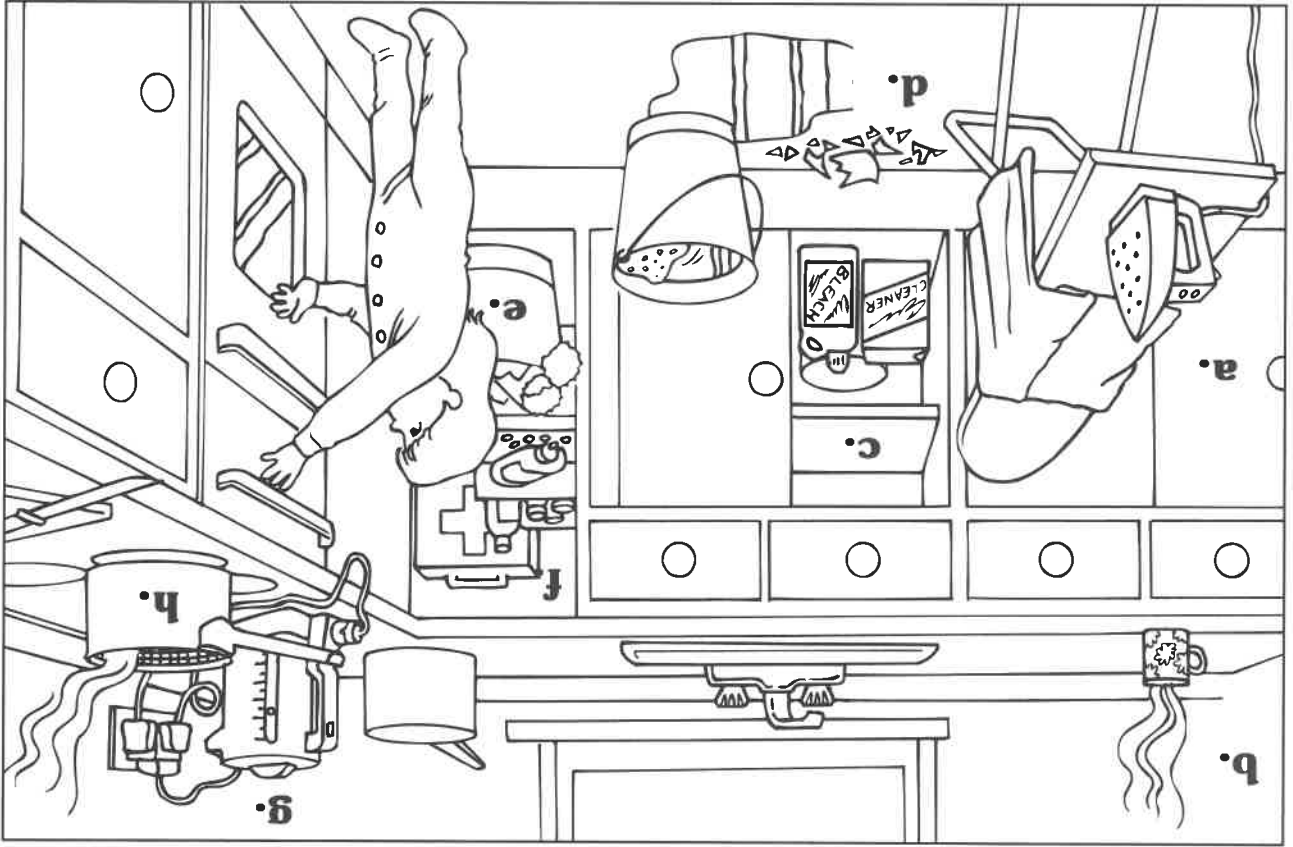


# Accidents Waiting to Happen
